Reporting to the UK logistics Manager your role will include the below key skills and tasks:

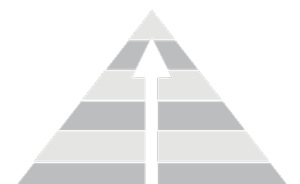
### Key Tasks:

- Approval and analysis of expenditure for TR UK Freight movement
- Analysing our trade routes to propose improvements to reduce the total cost of acquisition
- Ensuring the knowledge of the operations teams is maintained at all times around import/export

### The Candidate

The ideal candidate will have:

- Customs knowledge including export/import
- Experience in customs entries and Incoterms
- Experience in documentation in order to ensure goods are shipping in accordance with the regulations of the destination/origin
