The Role

Reporting to the Purchasing Team Leader, your role will be to improve the accuracy of demand data coming through the business to enhance customer service levels, optimise stock and support sales forecasting.

Key tasks include:

- Ensuring stock is line with Company policy in order to achieve optimum stock turn, to achieve total customer satisfaction
- Maintaining accurate branch records and effectively control stock, which will involve deferring stock to maximise cash flow
- Deploying and maintaining customer positioning matrix for demand planning
- Analysing and improving the short and long term demand forecast for the business
- Capturing and reporting any demand changes
- Reviewing key accounts where no forecast is supplied on monthly basis and the business wish to forecast
- Liaising with sales teams to improve the FC
- Arranging and attending review meetings with the sales and purchasing teams and any other person responsible
- Communicating with relevant parties data gathered to ensure inventory levels are amended quickly and efficiently
- Reviewing sales forecasts to work with the team responsible if they differ from previous reviews with the same mechanic/distribution
- Ensuring any variances over/below agreed percentage compared with sales FC are highlighted
- Creating and maintaining forecast models for/from our customers, incorporating business intelligence and forecast information gathered from sales, marketing, finance, and other sources

Working hours will be 37.5 hours per week, Monday to Friday 07:30 – 16:00 and Friday 08:30 – 15:45.
