To help raise money the team hosted a variety of activities including a turkey sandwich day, selling homemade cakes, a card appeal, and asking people for small donations from their food cupboards.

"These fundraising activities were a great way to come together to help our chosen charities, people have been so generous at a time when things are tough for most. We hope to host another day in April to raise money for The Black Country Foodbank and The Salvation Army."

Here are some of the ways that TR's donation will be utilised by the charities:

- Provides 147 meals and 49 toiletry packs to the local foodbank
- Helps The Salvation Army to provide a box of groceries and modest gifts, so that families who are struggling in poverty can share a basic meal together and offer one-to-one support work for a homeless person in one of their centres

- A donation of £165.00 to PAPYRUS covers the cost of training someone in ASIST, which is a twoday course that prepares caregivers to provide suicide first aid interventions
- A donation of £65.00 to PAPYRUS can keep their prevention helpline running for over one hour

The Black Country Foodbank comments:

"Thank you so much for collecting food and toiletries for families and individuals in your local community. We will use all the food you have donated to make emergency food parcels for people in crisis.

You have donated 73.4kgs of food and 49kgs of non-food, enough to provide 147 meals and 49 toiletry packs. This is absolutely wonderful, and we are so thankful that you have supported us in this amazing way!"
